

2011 STORY COUNTY YOUTH FAIR SPOTLIGHT ON YOUTH INFORMATION

**For Photography Exhibits, Friday, July 8 North Grand Mall 10 am -5 pm
For Visual Art Exhibits, Friday, July 8 North Grand Mall 2-5 pm
AND
For Fair Entry Day Thursday, July 21 4-H Hall & Community Building 8:30 am – 1:00 pm**

If an exhibit receives an orange dot (being considered for a ribbon beyond a blue), then the exhibitor will have his/her picture taken **without their exhibit** at a designated location in the mall, 4-H Hall, or the Community Building. **Exhibitors will only have their picture taken one time in one of the three possible locations.** The exhibitor's picture may be displayed with his/her exhibit July 22-27 if the exhibit was selected to advance to the state fair.

For Livestock Exhibitors during the County Fair

Pictures of exhibitors with their champion livestock exhibits (may have received a trophy, champion ribbon, or reserve champion ribbon) will be taken at these times:

Monday at 4 pm - outside the sheep barn on the south side
Tuesday at 4 pm – outside the sheep barn on the south side
Wednesday at 4 pm - outside the sheep barn on the south side

Note*These livestock exhibitor photos will not be displayed, but will be used for news releases.**

Exhibitors can have their picture taken with each of their champion exhibits; therefore his/her picture may be taken on more than one day. If an exhibitor has a champion exhibit and is unable to have their picture taken at one or more of these designated times, then he/she should make arrangements with the Extension Office Monday-Wednesday 8 am – 5 pm.
